SUPERVISOR GUIDELINES

- Pick your evidence according to who you want to convict
 - When you pick evidence, match one or two of them to the powders found on the guilty one. This goes for powders, plastics, fibers, hair and fingerprints
 - (hair--make at least one of the samples human hair, seriously.
 It's not like humans weren't present at the scene.)
 - You could troll and make none of them match, but that's not necessarily recommended unless you really want to do that.
 - **IMPORTANT: When you pick fingerprints, pick two to be from the actual crime scene, and two for each suspect. That's just how the questions were written.
 - Maybe include one extra blank page for crime analyses since I somehow ended up with an even number of pages on the test content...
